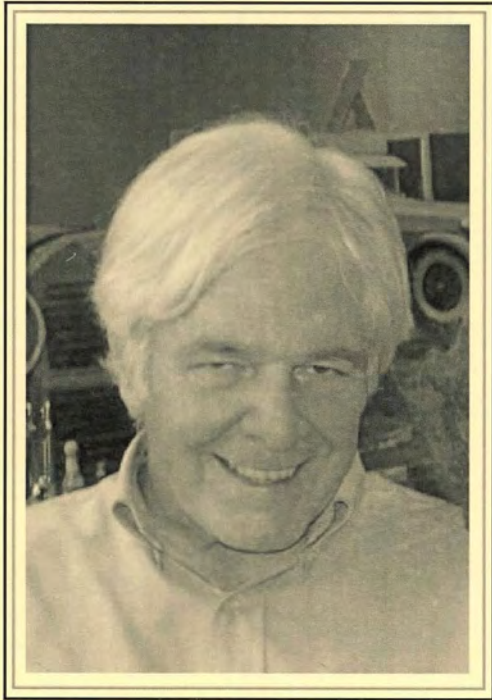

Born in Lockport, New York, on July 17, 1943, David graduated from Vanderbilt Law School with a J.D. in 1968 and practiced music copyright and contract law in Nashville, Tennessee, for 20 years. During that time he married Rebecca Oakley and they raised their three children—Robb, Caleb, Eliza—in Nashville. Moving to St. Louis, Missouri, to attend Covenant Seminary, he and Rebecca graduated in 1993. All three of their children graduated from Covenant Seminary or took extensive courses there as well.

After graduation the Ludwicks stayed in St. Louis and David served as President of ITEM (International Theological Education Ministries), teaching in Eastern Europe and scheduling laymen and pastors to do the same. During this time he also served on the Abila Board, worked at Twin Oaks Church in plant operations, holding weekly discussions (“theology time”) with those working with him there, and taught Sunday school at Covenant Church. Then in 2009, David and Rebecca moved to Salt Lake City to serve as teachers/administrators with Mission Utah. David also served on the Board of the Vine Institute in Salt Lake City.

He is survived by his wife, their three children, and eight grandchildren.

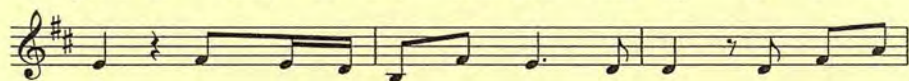
